



INDEPENDENCE DAY GUIDELINES



FIRE CONTROL

- Fires are permitted at Deland and King Park between 6:00 P.M. and 10:00 P.M. The diameter of the fire circle no larger than 36” and 18” above grade. At no time shall the smoke or heat be an annoyance or discomfort to anyone. Dry wood is the only allowable fuel and it cannot be ignited with flammable or combustible liquids.

FIREWORKS

- The sale and discharge of fireworks is prohibited in the City of Sheboygan. This includes anything manufactured, processed or packaged for exploding, emitting sparks or combustion which does not have another common use.

ALCOHOL POSSESSION/CONSUMPTION RESTRICTIONS

- Alcohol possession/consumption is prohibited in North Point Park, Deland Park, the beach area of General Charles King Park, the beach area of Lakeview Park, Elwood H May Environmental Park, Fountain Park, Vollrath Park, Sheridan Park, Northeast Park, Optimist Park, Voight Park, Franklin Park, Moose Park, Jaycee Park, Indian Mound Park, Workers Water Street Park, and Riverside Park.
- Alcohol possession and consumption is permitted in Deland Park, only in the area south of the North Pier.
- Alcohol is permitted in Rotary and General Charles King Park (grass area only).

EXCAVATIONS AT BEACHES

- Pits, ditch trenches and other excavations are prohibited for the day of the July 4th celebration.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Boats and other watercraft are prohibited from all beaches.
- Bicycles and other vehicles are prohibited from the North and South piers.
- Dogs and cats are prohibited from city parks.
- Glass beverage containers are prohibited from all city parks.
- Vehicles are prohibited from the walks or lawns of any parks, unless specially designated for that use.
